**In March, we completed an Author Study about Robert Munsch. We loved reading the silly books every day!**

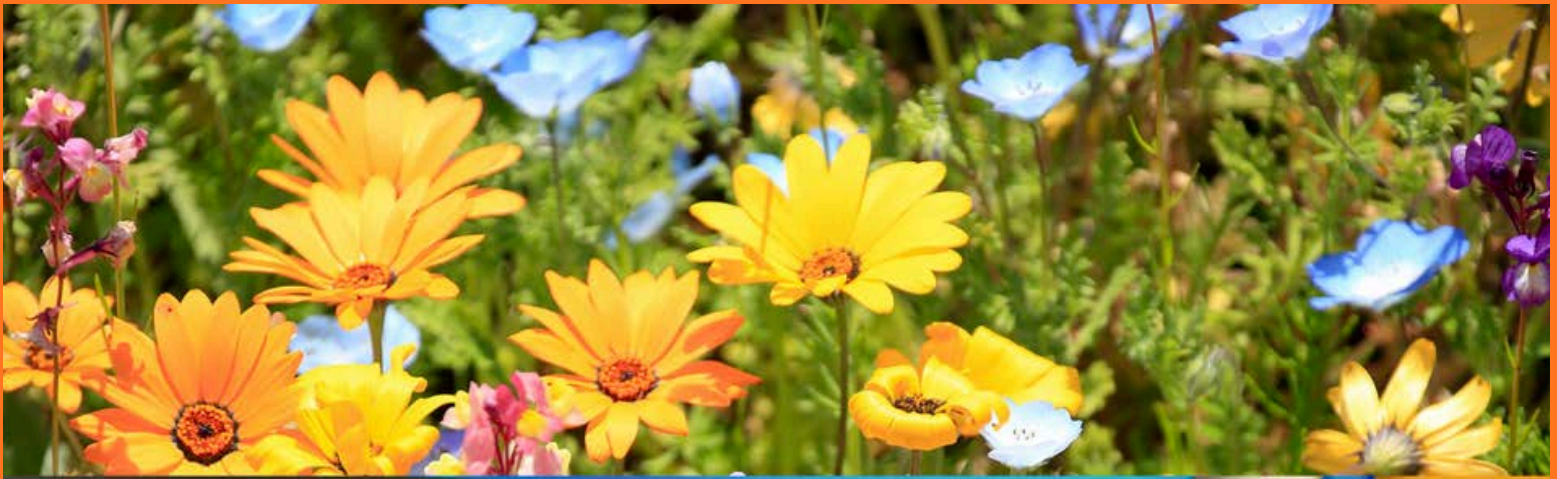
**We had Jill Larock join us for a health class to share what it is like to visit a nurse/doctor and taught us about some of the organs in our body!**
