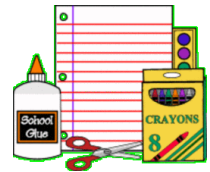


Grade 5/6 School Supply List



The following is a list of supplies that your child should bring for the first day of school. Please note that ***ALL*** supplies, including pencils, crayons, and pencil crayons, **need to be labeled** with their name or initials.

- 5 – 40 page Hilroy notebooks (no perforated pages or coil bound please)
- 3 – 80 page Hilroy notebooks (no perforated pages or coil bound please)
- 1 – 200 page notebook for spelling
- 4 duotangs
- 3 two pocket folders (look like duotang but just have pockets)
- 2 – 1 1/2" 3 ring binder (no zippered or fancy binders please)
- 10 divider pages for binders
- 1 package of Hilroy loose leaf (200 sheets)
- 40 (or more) HB pencils, sharpened
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- 3 white erasers
- 1 art sketch book
- 2 red pens/5 blue pens/1 black pen (more if your child tends to loose things or destroys them!)
- 2 pencil case (they will have 2 classrooms and need one to leave in each)
- 1pkg of fine tipped Sharpie markers
- 2 black sharpies
- 1 pkg broad tipped markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 package of 24 pencil crayons (sharpened)
- 1 package of 24 wax crayons
- 1 pkg clear tape
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 protractor (the smaller ones are easier to use)
- 1 centimeter ruler
- Headphones for use in the computer lab/iPad
- 1 dictionary (Gage if buying)(Some students left them on my shelf for the summer)
- 1 set of gym clothes (shirt, shorts/sweat pants, socks and gym shoes with non marking soles) in a backpack or tote bag
- 2 large boxes of Kleenex
- 1 well-rested, eager student!



Please feel free to reuse any school supplies from last year if they are in good shape. If you know your child goes through a lot of pens, pencils, and erasers, I recommend buying lots now as they tend to be cheaper and keep a stash at home! The first day of school in the fall is Tuesday, September 5th. I am looking forward to working with your child in the fall.
