Plenty Wheatland Regional Library

New to the Wheatland Regional Library are Read Along Books! The collection is called Read Alouds and features picture books with permanent built in speakers so kids can listen along to the story without any added devices. They are great for younger patrons including those who can't read yet but also those in early elementary as they can see the word and hear it at the same time. Patrons can borrow the books for up to 4 weeks with 2 renewals. Chargers are not included with the books as the books can be read up to 100 times before charging. The collection has about 70 items in and will float throughout the region. Right now we have the book Red: A Crayon's Story by Michael Hall at our library.
