



#### WILKIE HUNTERS SAFETY CLASS 2026

Hello Craig from Wilkie Hunters Safety. Here is the Info about the 2026 course. It will start January 5th and run every Monday night until about the beginning of March. The class is from 6:30pm to 9pm at the Handle Community Hall.

You must be at least 12 years old at the START of the class to get BOTH courses. The cost is \$120 per person. That gets you the Saskatchewan Hunters Safety Course AND Non-Restricted Federal courses. When you come on the first night you will need a pen, pencil, eraser, highlighter.








Dear Gift Givers.
