



### **Principal's Message**

Last year the Ministry of Education announced a directive regarding cellphone use in schools in Saskatchewan. As such, cellphones are not permitted during class time for students at NWCS. In Grades 9-12 there are some planned exceptions. Teachers will direct when students can use cellphones for learning purposes, in consultation with administration.

This directive is intended to lessen the negative impacts of personal electronic devices in classrooms and support teachers and school staff in promoting productive classroom environment. The use of personal electronic devices by students in school has been demonstrated to:

- \* Increase incidents of distraction
- \* Contribute to problematic social media use
- \* Affect students' ability to build connections with their peers
- \* Be associated with acts of bullying, including cyberbullying
- \* Be associated with a range of behavioral and mental health issues affecting students

(Sun West School Division Administrative Procedure 140)

Cellphones will be silenced and are not to be operated by students during instructional time, including all classroom activities, assemblies and any other learning environment within the school. In addition, cellphones may not be used at any time where individual privacy must be protected such as washrooms and changing rooms. We expect that our staff will model appropriate cellphone use for our students.

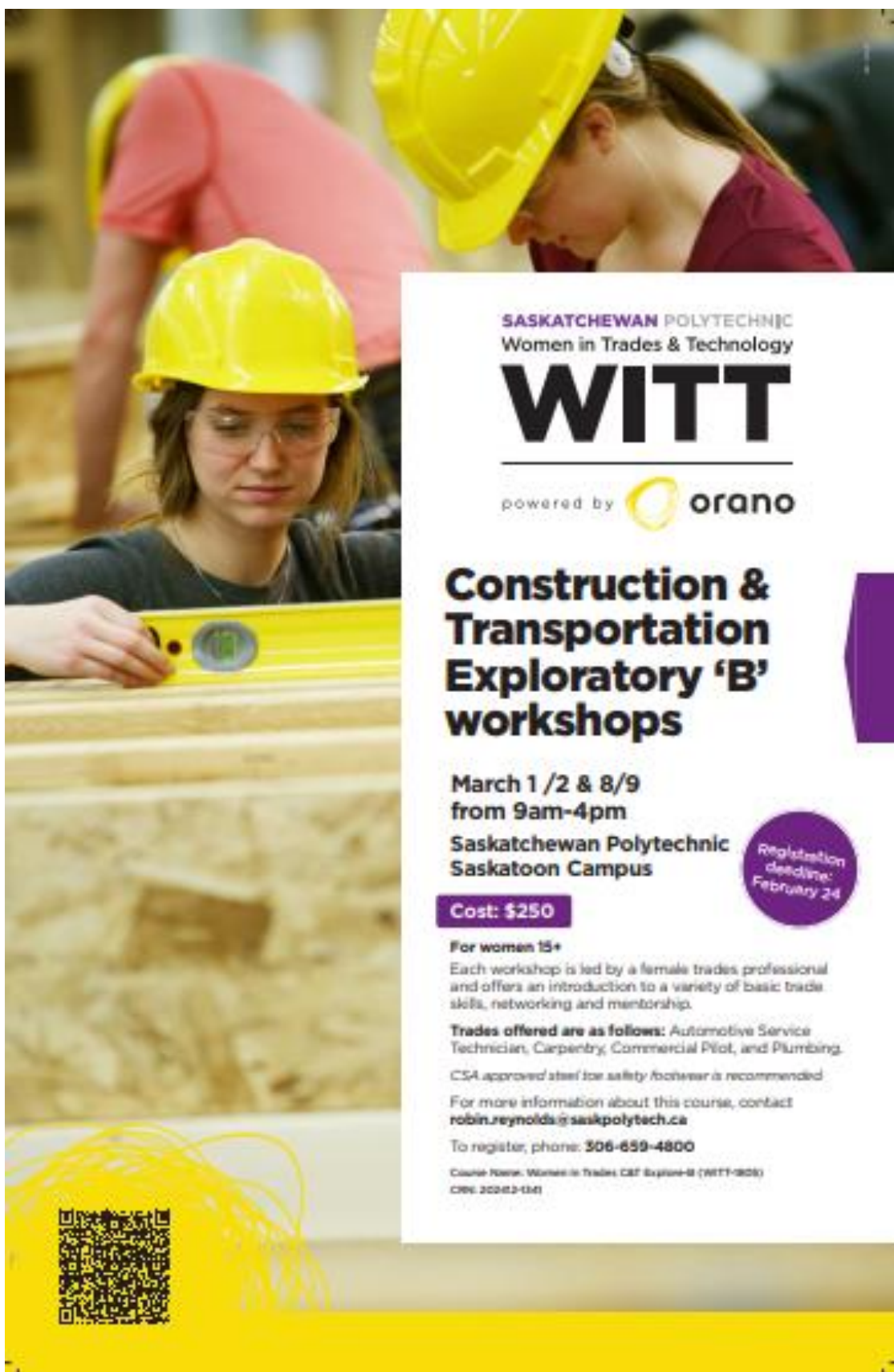
