We are trying something new for the month of February: Lego and Craft clubs have switched days!

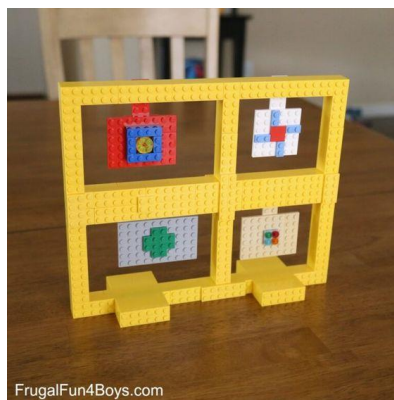
Craft Club 3:30- 4:30 Tuesdays
